

STATEMENT

Fibrous Raw Material Sources – 2010

During 2010, Portucel Soporcel group incorporates, in its processes around 78% of Eucalyptus Globulus wood from the Iberian forest (national and Spanish - Galicia) and 22 % of the imported eucalyptus wood from Brazil, Chile, Congo and Uruguay. The acquisition of timber from these sources was made by FSC and PEFC certified suppliers. Certified wood represented about 36 % of the total wood consumption.

The gPS only uses wood of the following categories:

- Pure or mixed certified wood (PEFC or FSC);
- FSC Controlled wood;
- Controlled material.

The Portucel Soporcel group incorporates softwood pulp in the production of certain papers, this fiber comes from Finland, Sweden, Baltic States and Russia forests. This pulp was acquired from certified FSC and PEFC suppliers and produced mainly with pine, birch and spruce species.

In accordance with the settlement assumed in the Politics of the Management Systems, to incorporate in its production process only fibrous certified material or of controlled origin, the Portucel Soporcel group guarantees, through a risk analysis that all not certified acquired fibrous material, wood and long fiber, does not have unacceptable origin, such as:

- Wood harvested in violation of traditional and civil rights;
- Wood harvested in forests where high conservation values are threatened by management activities;
- Wood from forests in which genetically modified trees are planted.
- Illegally harvested wood;
- Wood harvested in forests being converted to plantations or non- forest use.
